## Class 3: Summer Term Work

Dear Parents,

I hope you all had a restful Easter and are ready for what will be a very exciting and long summer term.

We had a very good first week and I hope to build on the excellent start we have made. It will be a busy half term and I have outlined some aspects of work we will be covering below:

**History - 'People in Tudor Times'** - an introduction for the children to the lives of people in Tudor times with a focus on Christopher Columbus.

**Science - 'Hot and Cold/Sound'** - investigating and extending the children's understanding of: temperature and how to measure it, sound and how we hear.

**Music - 'the Class Orchestra'** - an exploration of what instruments make up an orchestra

**D & T - 'Playgrounds and Picture Frames'** - an exploration of what equipment we have in our playground and the process of designing a piece. A project to design and make a frame for a photograph or picture.

**P.E.** - this will be on a **Tuesday and Wednesday**, which will be **Athletics and Outdoor Activities**. Depending on the weather we will try to get outside for all games sessions so it would be helpful if children could bring some warm outdoor clothes such as leggings and sweatshirts, and appropriate shoes please. The children will need their P.E. t-shirt and shorts for inclement weather. Please could you ensure that **all** clothing, including pants and socks, are labelled.

**I.C.T.** - **'Images'** - to develop the children's skills in using art package software to draw and manipulate images.

**Homework**

I will continue to send this home on Friday and ask that it be returned to school on Wednesday morning. This is to give me chance to mark the handwriting homework which the children will be undertaking on a weekly basis. Other tasks will be supporting the work we will be covering in class, as well as spellings to be learnt, 'off by heart'.

If you feel you have anything to contribute to this half term's work then please let me know or send things in with the children.

As always, if at any time you are anxious about anything at all, please come and see me at the end of the day, or phone school.
